- o Confirmation of all securities held by Smith Barney.
- o Reconciliation of all such securities to the books and records of the Company and the Custodian.
- o Agreement of three security purchases and two security sales since our last report from the books and records of the Company to the Company's bank statements.

We believe that our examination provides a reasonable basis for our opinion. Our examination does not provide a legal determination on the Company's compliance with specified requirements.

In our opinion, management's assertion that Capital Southwest Corporation and subsidiary complied with the requirements of subsections (b) and (c) of rule 17f-2 of the Investment Company Act of 1940 as of December 31, 2007, with respect to securities reflected in the investment account of the Company is fairly stated, in all material respects.
